

Kingswood Uniform Policy

Our school colours are blue, white and grey. We have a school uniform for a variety of reasons. These include giving the children a sense of pride in their school, giving a school identity and a sense of belonging and membership. We want our pupils to be smart ambassadors for the schools when they are out and about in the community.

Uniform: all items below are required as school uniform

My Clothing and Your Image supply our branded School uniform. The home page of the website has a link to both sites. Items with the embroidered logo are polo shirts, sweatshirts, cardigans, rucksack, reversible fleece and house T Shirts. All items must be labelled.

The Friends and Parents Teachers Association (FPTA) holds half termly second-hand uniform sales, a range of good quality uniform is available. If you require a full starter uniform bundle, the FPTA are happy to take ad-hoc requests. Please email kpsfpta@gmail.com

Shoes: Sensible black, flat healed, leather shoes should be worn for normal school hours. Trainers, boots, ballet type shoes and sling-backed heels are not acceptable. Open-toed shoes are not permitted for safety reasons (as a guide - if they can't be polished then they are unlikely to be suitable school shoes).

Jewellery: Standard analogue (preferable) or digital watches are permitted. Plain studs are permitted for pierced ears however children will need to be able to remove these themselves for all P.E. sessions. No other jewellery, including 'smart' watches, is permitted.

Ear piercing should only take place at the beginning of the summer holiday to avoid children being excluded from P.E. as a result of new ear piercings. However if you wish your child to continue wearing their earrings during PE then you will need to complete the form at the end of this policy (see appendix 1).

Book bag: Children in EYFS, Years 1 and 2 should have a blue book bag.

Hair styles: Shoulder length or longer hair must be tied up with a navy or white hair band. All hair styles should be appropriate to a primary school environment i.e. without effects like tram lines and Mohicans.

Makeup and nail varnish: These are not permitted.

Religious and cultural customs: The schools will take into consideration religious and cultural customs where parents make a request for a reasonable adjustment to the current school uniform. Such requests must be made in writing for the attention of the Headteacher who will consider the request.

Pierced Ears
