Every child is valued, supported and empowered to thrive. This includes pupils who are educationally disadvantaged and eligible for Pupil Premium.

Key challenges for Pupil Premium pupils

- Lower average attendance than non-disadvantaged peers
- Very low progress for disadvantaged pupils with SEND
- Lower attainment and progress in Writing and Maths
- Lower reading fluency linked to attainment and progress
- Lower spoken language and listening skills on entry
- High levels of SEMH needs for pupils and families
- Limited wider experiences / cultural capital
- Some pupils recognised as young carers

Teaching

- Quality First Teaching through effective CPD
- Focus on Precision Teaching
- Subject leadership release for a sequenced written curriculum
- ECT development through training, release time and support

Targeted academic support

- Little Wandle Phonics: leadership, training, resources and tutoring
- Maths Mastery implementation and Maths Hub engagement
- Literacy For All: engagement, reading for pleasure and fluency
- Nessler, NELI and ELKLAN for language and foundational knowledge

Wider strategies

- Attendance strategies: family work, monitoring and external support
- SEMH and wellbeing, including nurture club and ELSA
- Financial contributions for basics and enrichment
- Targeted parental engagement and family support
- Animal-assisted therapy at Kingswood Shetlands
